Motion passed unanimously.

Monthly reports were given by department heads and councilmembers.

On a motion made by Jackson and seconded by Adams, and in accordance with KRS 61.810(1)(b) and with Adams, Rodgers, Jackson, Parrott, Todd, Herndon, and Johnny Lee Jackson voting yea and with none voting nay, Council entered into an executive session for discussion on litigation concerning the opioid epidemic with the big four para companies.

On a motion made by Herndon, seconded by Rodgers, and with Johnny Lee Jackson, Herndon, Todd, Parrott, Jackson, Rodgers and Adams voting yea and with none voting nay, Council returned to regular session.

No action was taken during the executive session.
