On a motion made Adams, add seconded by O'Nan, with Cox, Summers, Potts, O'Nan, Whitnell, McDonald, Jackson, Myers, Adams, and Elder voting yea and with none voting nay, Council approved **Resolution 10-2-17** "a resolution declaring property as surplus." Motion passed unanimously.
