CITY COUNCIL MINUTES CITY OF MAYFIELD, KENTUCKY

December 14, 2020

The City Council of the City of Mayfield, Kentucky, met in a meeting on Monday, December 14, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. at city hall. There were present Mayor Kathy S O'Nan, Fire Chief, Ambulance Director & Community Development Coordinator, Jeremy Creason, Police Chief Nathan Kent, Public Works Director Russ Brower, City Attorney Bo Neely, and City Clerk Tamie Johnson.

Council members present were as follows:

Police Chief, Nathan Kent, opened the city council meeting.

Councilmember Nate Cox led the council in prayer.

Councilmember Phil Myers led the council in the pledge to the American flag.

Mayor O'Nan gave the oath of office to Jerry Gore, who was recently employed by the Mayfield Police Department.

Police Chief, Nathan Kent, presented the 2020 Governor's Impaired Driving Enforcement Award to Officer Cody Rodgers.

Councilmember Barry McDonald gave council an update on the Spectrum cable franchise agreement, that is up for renewal.

The following citizens addressed the council concerning the selling of their neighborhood lagoon and the desire by some to be annexed into the city;

On a motion by Jackson, seconded by Myers and with Herndon, Parrott, Cox, Myers, Whitnell, McDonald, Jackson, Adams, Todd, and Rodgers voting yea, and with none voting nay, Council approved the minutes of the November 9, 2020 meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

On a motion made by Cox, seconded by Whitnell and with Rodgers, Todd, Adams, Jackson, McDonald, Whitnell, Myers, Cox, Parrott and Herndon voting yea and with none voting nay, Council approved on first reading **Fiscal Ordinance 3-20**, a fiscal ordinance amending Fiscal Ordinance 2-20 "an ordinance adopting the annual budget and scheduled salaries for the City of Mayfield, Kentucky, for the fiscal year July 1, 2020 through June 32, 2021 estimating revenues and resources and appropriating funds for the operation of city government." Motion passed unanimously.

On a motion made by Cox, seconded by Myers, and with Herndon, Parrott, Cox, Myers, Whitnell, McDonald, Jackson, Adams, Todd, and Rodgers voting yea and with none voting nay, Council approved **Resolution 12-1-20**, a resolution changing the employee annual longevity lumpsum payments into an hourly rate which will be added to their current rate of pay. Motion passed unanimously.

On a motion by Jackson, seconded by Myers and with Rodgers, Todd, Adams, Jackson, McDonald, Whitnell, Myers, Cox, Parrott, and Herndon voting yea and with none voting nay, Council approved **Resolution 12-2-20**, a resolution

recommending a one-time retention incentive of \$2,500 be offered to the remaining veteran officers and the records/evidence custodian of the MPD, less the chief, who remain employed with the department through June 30, 2021. Motion passed unanimously.

On a motion by McDonald, seconded by Cox and with Rodgers, Todd, Adams, Jackson, McDonald, Whitnell, Myers, Cox, and Parrott voting yea and with Herndon voting nay, Council approved **Resolution 12-3-20**, a resolution authorizing the completion of the public works building's interior. The combined cost of items yet to be completed is \$115,000.00 and is also an unbudgeted item. Motion passed nine to one.

On a motion by Cox, seconded by Herndon, and with Herndon, Parrott, Cox, Myers, Whitnell, McDonald, Jackson, Adams, Todd and Rodgers voting yea and with none voting nay, Council approved **Resolution 12-4-20**, a resolution correcting the misnumbered resolution (10-1-20) to purchase a salt spreader. Motion passed unanimously.

Monthly reports were given by department heads and councilmembers.

With no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 6:28 p.m.
