January 25, 2022

The City Council of the City of Mayfield, Kentucky, met in a regular meeting on January 25, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. at the Purchase Area Development District. There were present Mayor Kathy O’Nan, Fire Chief, Ambulance Director & Community Development Coordinator, Jeremy Creason, Police Chief Nathan Kent, Public Works Director Russ Brower, City Attorney Bo Neely, and City Clerk Tamie Johnson.

Police Chief, Nathan Kent, opened the city council meeting.

Mayor O’Nan led the council in prayer.

Councilmember Todd led the pledge to the American flag

Hank Stoppelbein, with the Howarth Group, located in Franklin TN, spoke to council and those in attendance, to make them aware, that he was available to help homeowners be certain that their insurance had paid all they should have.

Katherine Brown, Mayfield Ky, addressed the council concerning the lack of information being given to the victims following the tornado.

Gregg Knight, 608 N 6th St, Mayfield KY, asked the council for help locating a structural engineer.

NEW BUSINESS

On a motion by McDonald, seconded by Rodgers, with Carr, Todd, Rodgers, Jackson, Whitnell, McDonald, Herndon and Johnny Lee Jackson voting yea and with Parrott recusing, Council approved on first reading **Ordinance 1-22** “an ordinance of the City of Mayfield to allow any City of Mayfield homeowner, whose home was destroyed by the December 10, 2021 tornado, and who used said home as a primary residence, and whose home was non-conforming prior to the December 10, 2021 tornado, to be rebuilt with the same non-conformity and continue its previous non-conforming use”. Motion passed eight to one recuse. Mr. Parrott recused himself as he is presently a board member for Hope of Homes, which plans to help rebuild homes in this area.

On a motion by Jackson, seconded by Parrott, with Johnny L Jackson, Herndon, Parrott, McDonald, Whitnell, Jackson, Rodgers, Todd and Carr voting yea and with none voting nay, council approved **Resolution 1-1-22** “a resolution supporting the submittal of an application for the Community Development Block -CV Grant 2022 to assist in the construction of a new fire house. Motion passed unanimously.

Report was given by Al Chandler concerning committees being formed for long term and immediately need recovery.

Report was also given by Integrity Group concerning progress being made under the contract.

Tornado updates were given by department heads.

With no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
